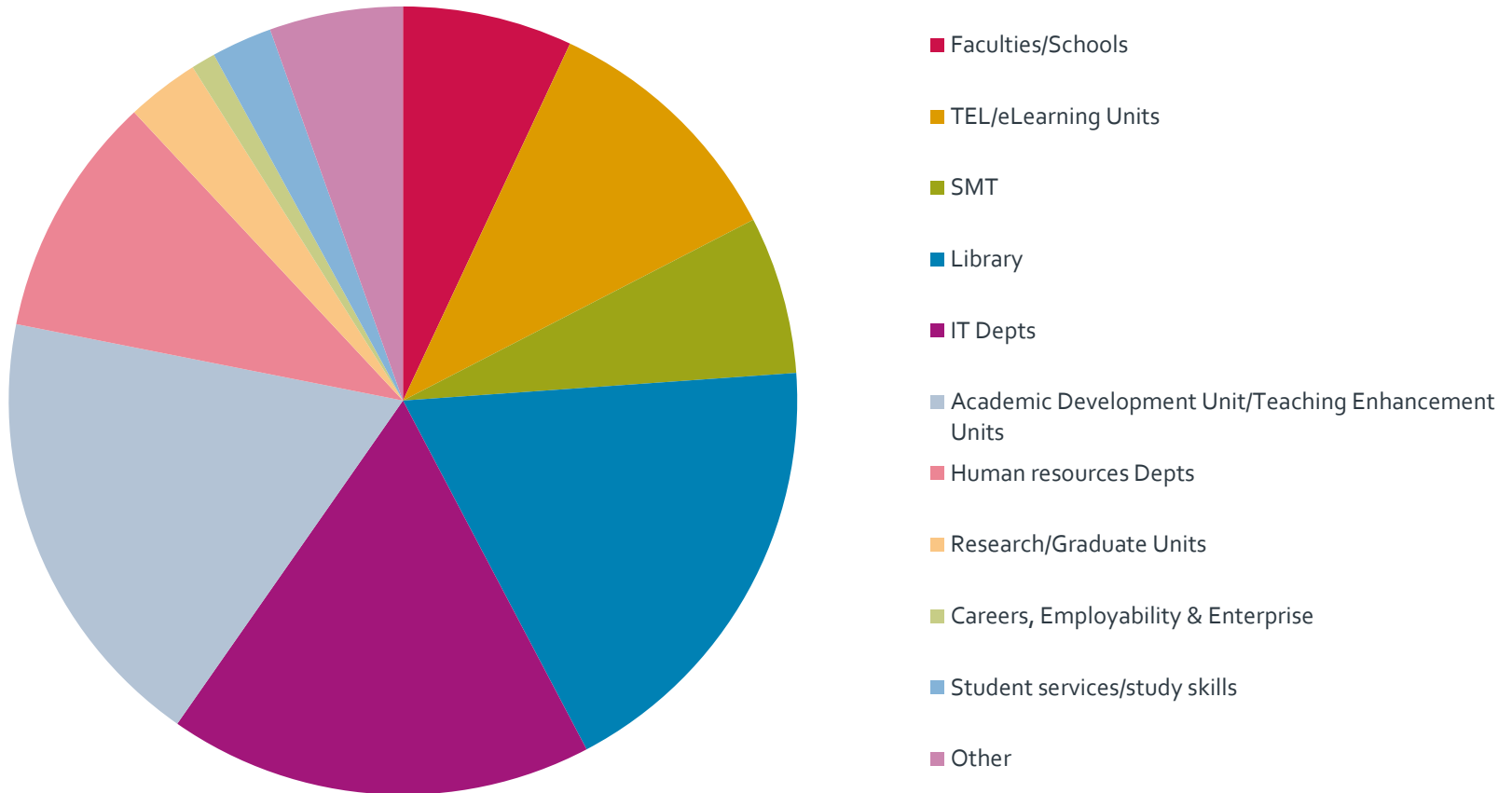

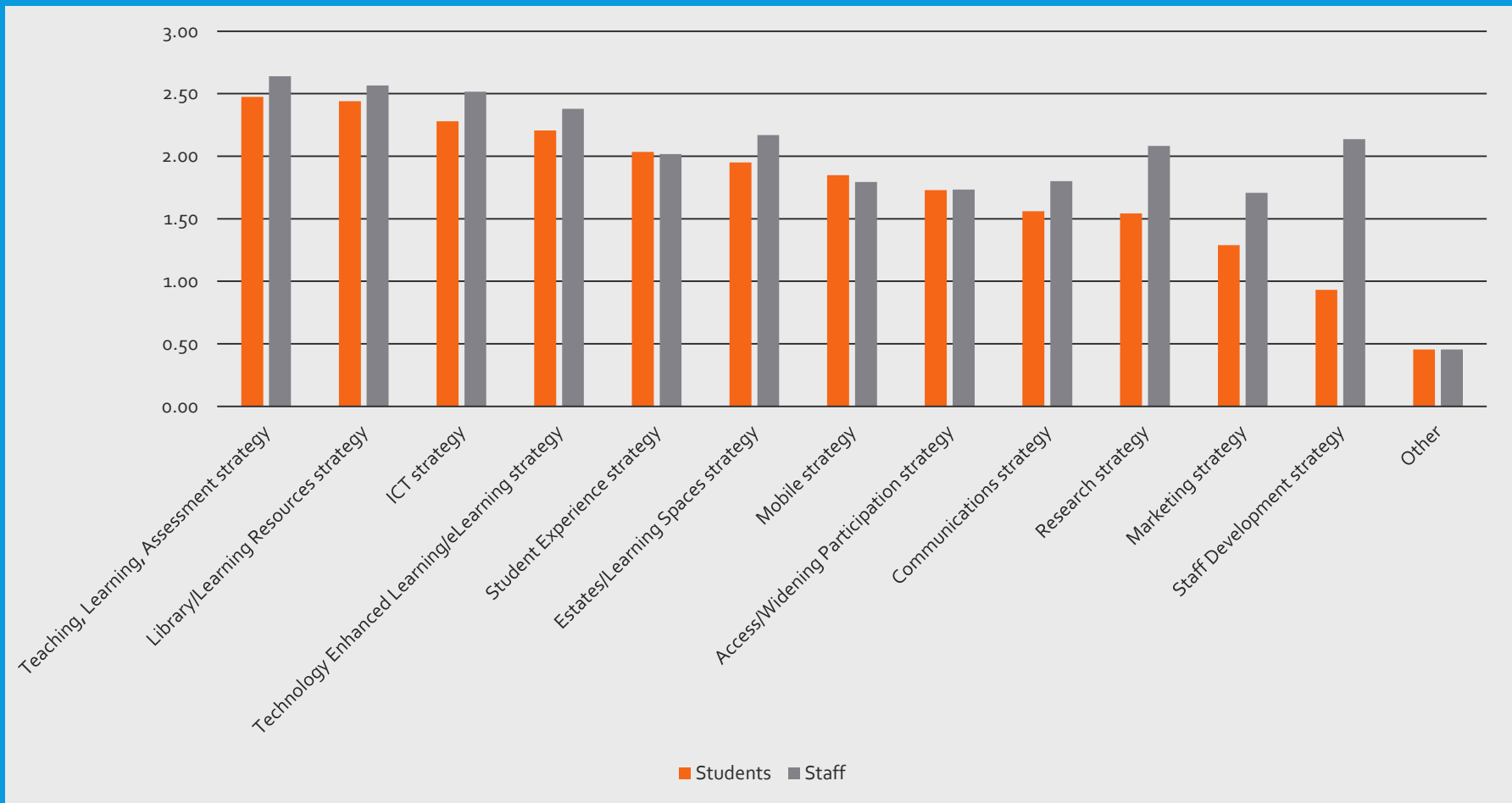

7	Other restrictions	7	11

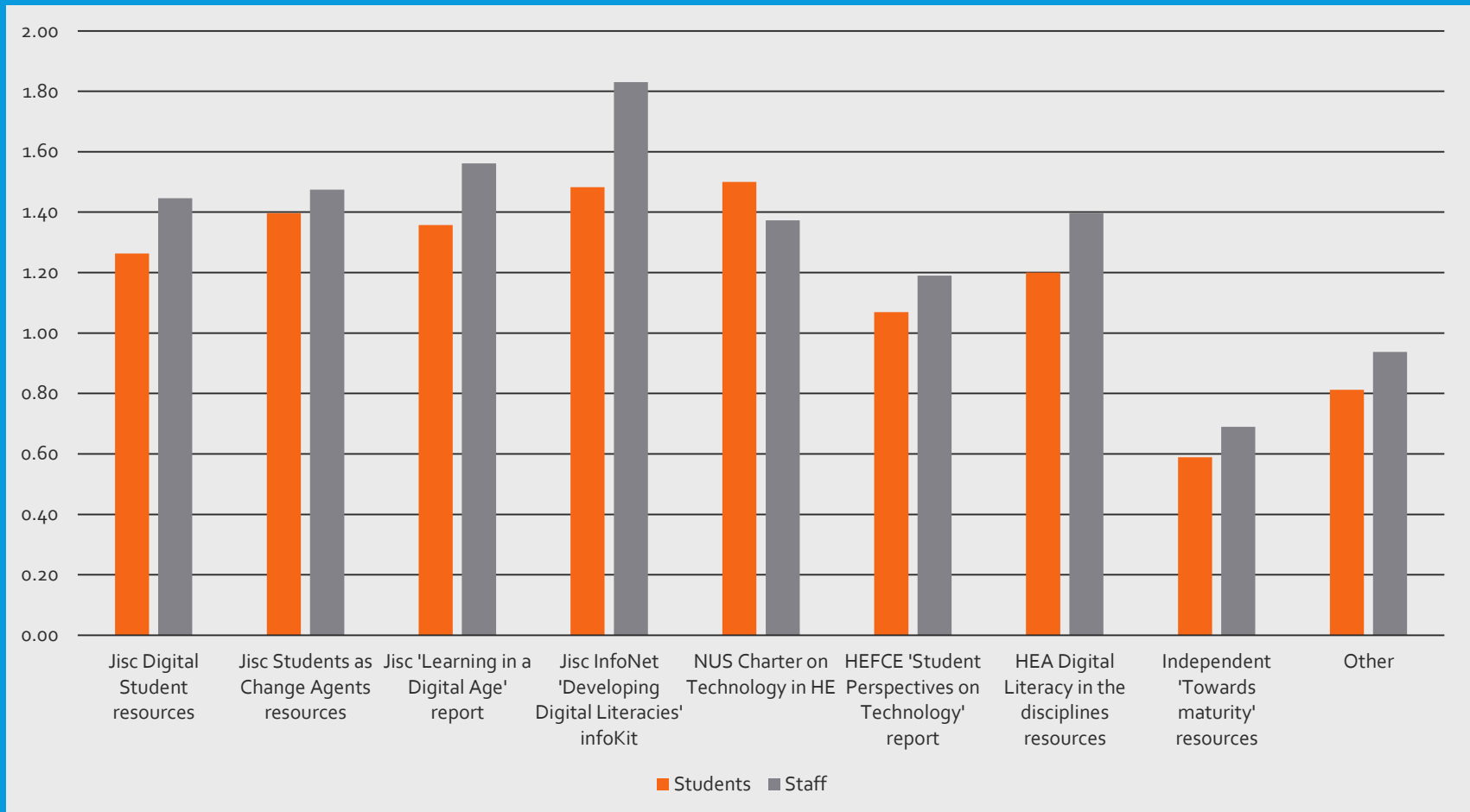
Collaborate to develop better software req's

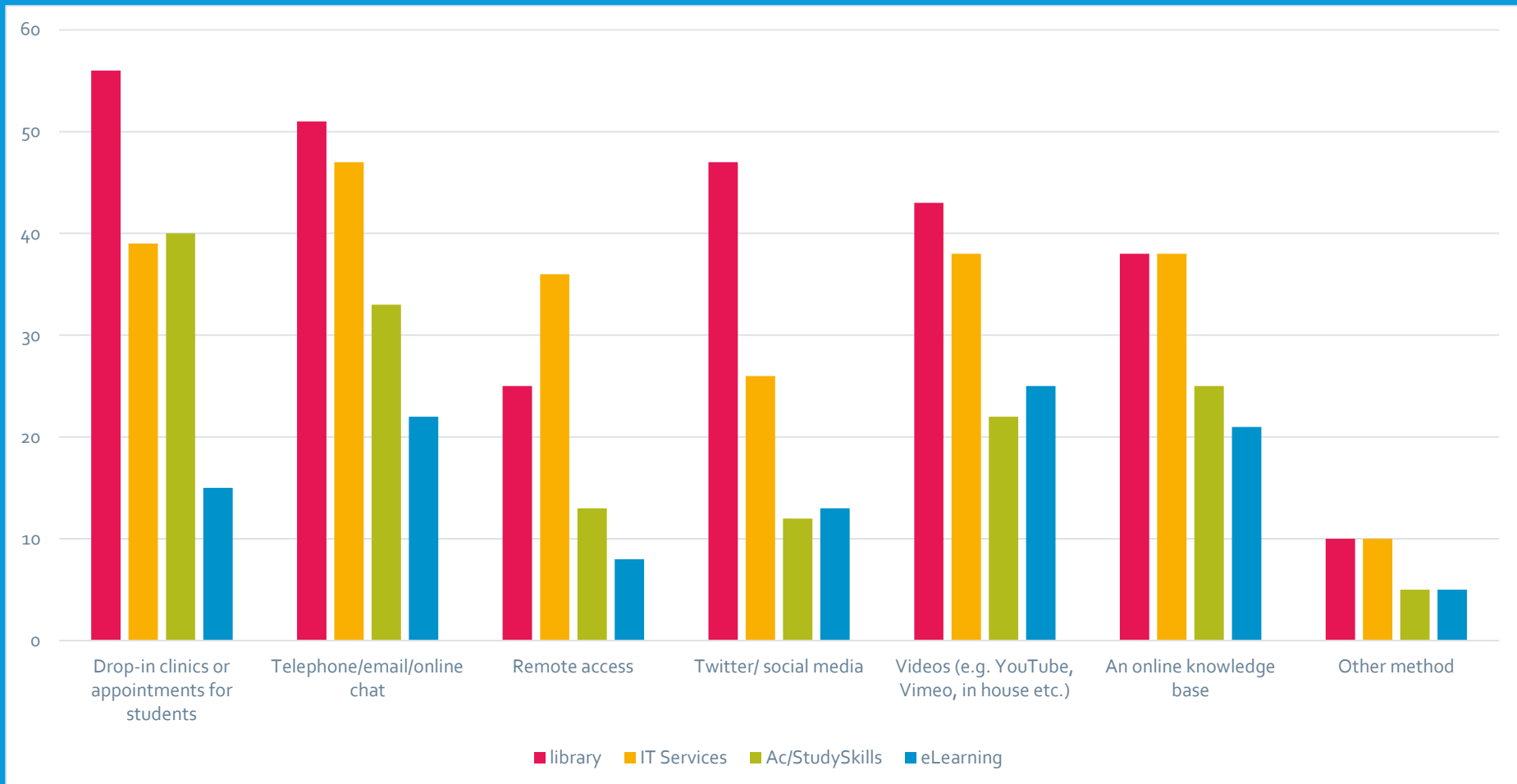
